You will meet several theater ushers. Ushers will be dressed in colorful festival t-shirts. They will take your ticket, help you find a seat, and give you something squishy to squeeze.



You might also meet a Festival Guide, Guides are friendly helpers who might share a funny joke or help you decide where to go or what activities to participate in.



You might be able to participate in fun activities in the lobby before the show.



You can ask your grown up if you need to use the restroom or get a drink of water.








At the end of the journey, we will pack up our things, and explore the rest of the Children's Festival or you may return home.
