Here are the main theater doors.








You may stop at the Box Office to pick up your tickets.

You will walk through a set of doors & go through metal detectors. They are there to keep you safe.




Inside, you will meet many of our ushers. The ushers will take your ticket and help you find a seat for the show!

Use the restroom and wash your hands.




You don't have to do anything you are not comfortable doing.

It will teach you how you can help keep the Earth happy and healthy.




Last, you will hear It's Okay to Be Different.
